PLEASE NOTE:

HOTEL POLICY:

The hotel rates above are the "Best Available Rate" as of today and not reserved. Once rooms are reserved and confirmed the rates may fluctuate slightly, based on the correct price on the day of booking. We will always do our best to minimize cost increases.

PASSPORT / VISA INFORMATION:

Passports must be valid for at least six months from the date of departure from the USA. On entering Israel, your passports are not stamped. Instead you will receive a stamped form with a visa valid for 3 months. Please keep this form as you will need it for hotel check in, car rental, bank affairs, entry to the Knesset, etc.

#### CANCELLATION POLICY:

If cancellation is received in our office:

1. From date of payment of deposit until September 1, 2021 – \$500 per person will be charged.
2. Between September 1 to October 1, 2021– \$1000 will be charged.
3. From October 1, 2021- full payment will be charged.
4. Cancellation of various elements in the program less than 7 days prior to the event may well result in a full cancellation charge.
5. Covid-19 clause: In the event that, your home country/state and/or Israel is officially considered a “red zone state”, and official Coronavirus restrictions are in place, prohibiting flights, entrance to Israel or requiring mandatory isolation, which will force you to cancel your trip, then a full refund will apply. As well, for any cancellation due to coronavirus illness, backed up by medical documentation – full refund will apply.

#### INSURANCE:

Insurance for baggage, personal items, health coverage and trip cancellation and interruption is not included, but is highly recommended. We suggest obtaining coverage through your local provider. Contact Sharon at Sababa Travel for more information and to purchase insurance.

#### VAT TAX REGULATIONS:

According to Israeli tax laws, enforced by hotels, guests holding Israel citizenship, even those with dual citizenship/passports both for individual travelers and guests part of a group, or invited local guests (including students living in Israel, even for a short time), will be charged VAT tax. Moreover, any guests holding a visa **other than** a B2, B3, B4 Tourist Visas and special entry permits such as diplomats **will be** charged VAT. Therefore, we must receive this information in advance in order to finalize the bill. Should we not receive this information in advance, and hotels charge us VAT, you will be charged this amount retroactively.
